Fusatsu is a time to review and reconsider where you personally stand in regard to the precepts. After the precept for the month is chanted please take the precept into your heart and sit with it. If you wish to speak about the precept, about where you now are regarding the precept, please do so. If you feel there are changes in your understanding and application of the precept and wish to speak about this, please do so. It doesn't matter if you have "taken" the precepts by way of the Jukai Ceremony.

The Chanter now says, "The Precept for the month of (say the month) is...."
